Skills for Independence - More and more we are noticing that students are missing some really important skills for them to be successful! Here are some skills that are important to actively teach our children:

- getting dressed and undressed for outside independently
- asking an adult for help e.g. Can I go to the bathroom? Can I have a Band-Aid? I forgot my lunch, can you help?
- children should know their full day and the full name of their parents
- children should know a phone number of a trusted adult and should know how to make a phone call
- children should understand that following the direction of a trusted adult is part of their job as a child
- children should be able to manage their own lunch and bathroom routine

As children get older, our expectations should increase. We believe that our job as teachers and parents/adults, is to teach children to be as independent as possible for their developmental age. This allows children to build confidence in themself and be proud of what they can do! We ask that you please practice some of these things with your children to make all our jobs easier!
