Here are some updates for you:

Food Restrictions Form - This past week, teachers sent home a small form to fill out to indicate whether your child has any food restrictions. On several occasions throughout the school year, the school or Home & School provides treats or snacks to students, and we want to ensure we take into consideration allergies and restrictions. If we don't receive the form back, we will assume your child has no food concerns to be aware of.

Finding Nemo Jr. Update - Wow! We are excited to have so many students interested in participating in the musical! Over 100 students turned in their paperwork. We have completed individual auditions for students that would like a featured or lead role in the musical. Next week, we will have group auditions for students that prefer a smaller role or would rather perform in a group. Those students will audition together in groups of about 15. Students being considered for lead or featured roles have received an invitation to a second audition after school on Tuesday, October 14th. Some students from that group will be invited to a Callback audition. Further instructions will be provided to those students.
